

TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS TRAVEL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Pre-travel requirements for the Turks and Caicos Islands



Negative COVID-19 PCR Test result.
The test must have been taken no more than 5 days prior to arrival.

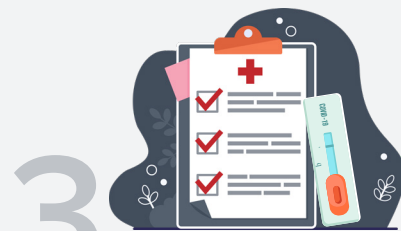
- Rapid Test
- Antibody Test
- RT-PCR Nasopharyngeal or Oropharyngeal test.



You must complete the application process **24 hours prior to your planned arrival.**



Medical insurance which covers **Medevac**. Available on **TCISafe.com**



Submit **Negative COVID-19 PCR test and Travel Insurance documents** to the TCI Assured Portal.

Visit **TCISafe.com** for more information on PCR Testing and to purchase Government approved travel insurance.

Proof of all of mentioned documents must be uploaded to the **TCI Assured Portal** which is available on the Tourist Board's website - **www.turksandcaicostourism.com**

Travelers must submit the application process no less than **24 hours prior to arrival**. Once uploaded, the documents will be verified and a **TCI Assured certificate** will be issued to the traveler which grants government approval to travel.

PCR TESTING REQUIRED FOR TRAVEL

A PCR test should be completed no more than five (5) days before your schedule date of travel to the Turks and Caicos. Results should be upload to the TCI Assured portal no less than 24 hours before arrival
